A. PURPOSE

The Clinary Institute of America's committed to maintaining a safe and secure environment that is free of violence. This obligation includes eliminating recognized hazards from campus community that may contribute to violence or serious harm.

B. POLICY STATEMENT

No individual (student, staff, or faculty member or member of the general public) permitted to bring a Weapon or Replica of a Weapon of any kind or US College P

Weapon: Weapons include but are not limited to knives, firearms or guns (including starter pistols, paintball guns, and guns that shoot projectiles such as pellets, BBs, and airsoft beads), machetes, bombs/explosives, ammunition, slingshots, clubs, batons, chukka sticks, martial arts weapons, plastic/metal knuckles, electronic devices intended to stun or incapacitate (e.g. TASER), and bow and arrow combinations (including crossbows).

The following are excluded from this definition:

- a. A firearm or other Weapon in the possession of a law enforcement officer who is authorized to possess same, either on or off duty, by the employing law enforcement agency.
- b. Kitchen knives and other kitchen related equipment used to support the educational process.
