



Counselor, Therapist	Provide confidential resources to victims in Title IX cases. Able to confidentially give students options for reporting to campus authorities, local law enforcement, as well as community resources for medical and emotional support. <b>Speaking with a counselor does not constitute a formal report to the CIA.</b>
Assistant Dean, Student Affairs	Able to give students options for reporting to local law enforcement, as well as community resources for medical and emotional support. <b>Disclosing an incident to a CIA official requires them to report the information to the Title IX Coordinator.</b>
Residence Life and Housing Coordinator	On call Residence Life staff who would be most likely to receive an initial report of a Title IX incident. <b>Disclosing an incident to a Residence Life staff member requires them to report the information to the Title IX Coordinator.</b>
Student Life Coordinator	Able to give students options for reporting to local law enforcement as well as community resources for medical and emotional support. <b>Disclosing an incident to a CIA official requires them to report the information to the Title IX Coordinator.</b>
